

# The Stages of Graduated Response in Bristol for Schools

### QUALITY FIRST TEACHING

This is a style of teaching that emphasises high quality, inclusive teaching for all pupils in a class with individual pupils completing work at their level

# ORDINARILY AVAILABLE PROVISION

This is extra support or adjustments that schools should make. These are funded from the school budget which varies at each school, examples of types of support are <u>here</u>. Your child may have a target plan to help monitor this support

## ADVICE FROM OTHER SERVICES

School may refer your child to external services such as an educational psychologist. If they don't have funds for this, they should ask the council for support via a Support Plan or EHC needs assessment A support plan is used when schools need to access funding to provide short-term or temporary provisions pupils need. Schools, families & pupils create the plan together

## BRISTOL SUPPORT PLAN (£)

#### EDUCATION HEALTH CARE PLAN (£)

This is a statutory plan detailing support & provisions specific to a pupil's needs. Professionals, schools, families & pupils create the plan & the support is funded by the local council
